Candidate/Elected Member Requirements

- Candidates must be considered a student according to the University requirements set forth by the Registrar's Office.
- Candidates must have, and maintain, a cumulative GPA of at least a 2.5.
- Candidates for E-Board must have, and maintain, a cumulative GPA of at least 2.7
 - E-Board consists of President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer
- Candidates must be in in good academic and social standing at the time of candidacy and throughout their term in office.
- Candidates must not be on University Probation before or for the duration of their term in any position.
- Candidates must be full-time (12 semester hours or more) enrolled students.
- Candidates **MUST** be available to attend weekly SGA meetings. These meetings are scheduled for 4PM-6PM, every Monday, in the Landon Events Room or another designated location.
- Candidates must complete and submit ALL parts of the application, which includes form and providing a resume, and marketing flyer
