- 3. Understand the most common bone and tendon procedures.
- 4. Discuss new treatment options.

- 1. Define appropriate protocols and procedures applicable to HIV counseling, testing and reporting as defined by the Florida State Legislature.
- 2. Recognize and apply proper charting and other techniques to minimize risk in practice.

- 2. Properly clinically assess the chronic wound environment.
- 3. Identify the risk factors for limb loss.
