COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course is an intensive board review designed to assist podiatrists in preparation for the written and oral examinations offered through ABPS and ABPOPPM.

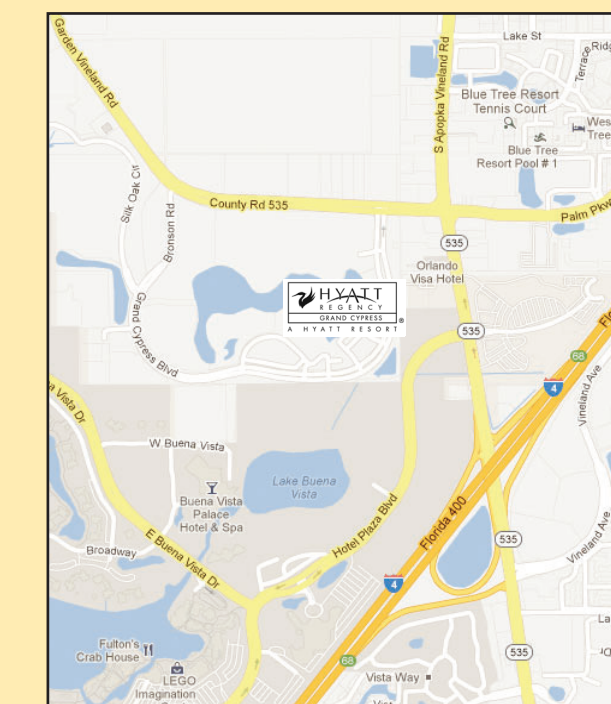
