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CHECKLIST FOR NEW STUDENTS (F1 & J1)

Visit the Office of International and Multicultural Programs (IMP) and check-in.

Please bring with all of your travel documents (Passport, Visa, I-94, and I-20/DS-2019).

IMP is located in Landon 202B.

Visit the Student Health Center as soon as possible.

Barry University requires all international students to provide the Student Health Center with proof of adequate health insurance or purchase the student sponsored health insurance plan. Additionally, you are required to complete and return a required health form and medical documentation prior to registering for classes and/or checking into residence. Medical documentation of the following vaccinations is required: Adult Tetanus (Td or Tdap, preferred) vaccination within the past 10 years; (2) measles, mumps, rubella (MMR) vaccines or, laboratory proof of immunity to measles, mumps, rubella. If you are residing in campus housing you must also provide proof of the Meningitis vaccination within the past 5 years.

Obtain your Barry University ID card.

Visit the Landon Student Union on the first floor to have your ID card issued.
